

Keep Warm over the Holiday Break—Make a Quilt!



If you want to learn how to make a quilt, come join me on Thursday afternoons [November 30th, December 7th, and December 15th] from 3:30 to 6:00; this is a really easy method which anyone can learn!

You will need to bring:

- A sewing machine that does a straight stitch and a zigzag stitch [bring the book!]
- All of the feet and other tools for the machine, including the bobbins!
- Top-stitch needles for you machine! [JoAnn, Sarah's Thimble]
- An extension cord
- A “jelly roll” or “Bali Pops” or Batik strip set [40 strips of 42” long by 2 ½ “ wide strips of COTTON [JoAnn, Sarah's Thimble, eBay/Etsy, Missouri Star Quilt Company <https://www.missouriqltco.com/>]



- Thread to match the strips [JoAnn, Michael's]
- Batting for a twin size bed [we can buy this later—field trip?]
- Backing fabric[we can buy this later!]
- Scissors
- Quilting pins [JoAnn, Michael's]
- Nickel-plated safety pins for quilting [JoAnn, Michael's]

If I think of anything else, I probably have it to share! I can accommodate about 6 people doing this, so if you are interested, let me know as soon as possible!

There WILL be “homework” if you want to be done by the break, but it will be more sewing of the type I will have already taught you.

I hope you will join me to make a quilt for yourself or as a fabulous Christmas/Hanukkah gift!
