Guidelines



Once again we will be making merry in the Upper School with Secret Santa / Hanukkah Harry / Kwanzaa Kevin / Bodhi Ben / Ramadan Ralphie / Yule Yorick / Divali Dennis activities during December—specifically on Tuesday, December 5th, Friday, December 8th, Tuesday, December 12th, Friday, December 15th, and Thursday, December 21st! [Participation is NOT required, but it's more fun when more people “play”!] To help make this run smoothly, participants may find the following guidelines helpful:

1. Students and teachers who wish to participate should fill out a slip for the drawing with their names and specific ideas of things they like and specific ideas of things they would NOT like to receive. Students who share first names should include last names to eliminate any confusion.
2. On the 5^h, 8^h, 12^h, and 15th each participant should give a small gift [candy, trinkets, poems, cards, etc.] to “his/her” person; on the 21st, each participant will bring a final gift [please keep the final gift in the \$10 - \$15 price range] for the Holiday Party. We will gather to make the final exchanges and reveal the identity of each gift giver.
3. PLEASE no offensive or inappropriate gifts!
4. Homemade gifts are always great for those who are talented and wish to share those talents with others!
5. All cubbies should be cleaned out and clearly marked, so using the cubbies for the small gifts/surprises should work easily!
6. **Keep your “person” a secret—that’s where the fun comes in!**
